" Listen to God "

How do we prepare the upper room of our hearts for a more full participation in liturgy?

It is necessary to open our ears to really LISTEN to the needs of those who congregate. Some quieting of the heart is necessary at various points throughout the liturgy. On occasion this may need to be gently explained in order to facilitate.

Before the gathering formally starts - make ourselves aware that we have taken time out to be with our community and with God. Make space in our hearts for God, Be open to the newness of God in this day and arrive with gratitude.

At the Penitential Rite, reflect on how we are with God and others - considers how we may change and what we are offering for transformation.

After the readings/Gospel, hear God speaking to our hearts, break the word open with the celebrant and make an initial response.

After Communion, take time to receive Christ's Body in full union with us, share conversation with Jesus, consider what Good News we are to carry from the gathering and give thanks.

Silence offers the opportunity to "PRAY" and not just to say prayers. Silence offers the fertile ground of our quiet and still hearts where a message may fall gently and find root in our lives. Silence and its quality experienced in liturgy may enable congregational members to realise the gifts which it offers in daily life.

Thank you for Listening to Jesus speaking to us every time we celebrate the Eucharist.
