In the wonderful document *Evangelii Gaudium*, Pope Frances speaks about dialogue being more than the communication of truth and goes on to say; "It arises from the enjoyment of speaking and it enriches those who express their love for one another through the medium of words." (E G 142). Maybe those words are food for thought for all of us. Do those of us who preach homilies consciously set out to express our love for the people in front of us? Do we know what a privilege we have to break open the Word of God and offer it to God's people as something which inspires and gives hope? The Holy Father says in the same paragraph "A preaching which would be purely moralistic or doctrinaire, or one which turns into a lecture of biblical exegesis, detracts from this heart-to-heart communication which takes place in the homily..." (142). If we are all called to preach the Gospel – and we are – then maybe prayerful mediation on our words and actions will assist us from time to time so that we will be trying always "to express our love for one another through the medium of words" and also ensure that all we do is done in the spirit of "heart to heart communication."

The homilies we preach, or the homilies of our lives come only from allowing God's Spirit to set our hearts on fire. That happens through our prayer and contemplation and allowing God to touch our hearts; it is then through our words and actions, through our presence to one another that we offer HOPE to those who are struggling with life. It is then that we become, as the Preface for Feasts of the Apostles used to say, "the living Gospel for all people to hear."
