Update from the Interim Parish Pastoral Council

The interim council had a meeting last Tuesday and made good progress towards the steps needed to bring about our new combined parish. The key points are:

The Name of our New Parish

There were approximately 70 submissions received. Of those 40 were in favour of 'Our Lady of Kapiti'. This does not include the 18 council members, the School Board of Trustees who had already given unanimous approval to that name.

Ten respondents suggested 'Our Lady of the Immaculate Conception' (or variations of this). A few other names were suggested with one or two people supporting each of those.

In light of that feedback, we will be recommending to Archbishop John Dew that our parish be named:

Our Lady of Kapiti

Te Whaea Tapu o Kapiti

Visioning

At the joint meeting of our two parishes in March, parishioners gave their initial thoughts (on plates) concerning a Vision for our new parish. We now need to cast the net wider so that everyone has an opportunity to contribute to this. The next steps will be:

The material from the plates will be displayed in both churches along with written contributions from the members of the interim council. Everyone will be invited to take part in a series of prayer/discernment small group sessions – Peter Ryan and Pat Haughey will be providing further information shortly.

The aim is to encourage as much input as possible. Individual submissions (sent to the parish offices) are also most welcome. There will be further communication as the details of the next stages are worked out – your thoughts on the process are always welcome.
