### Joint Parish Committee Meeting

Last week, a Joint Parishes Committee from Waikanae and Paraparaumu met to focus on the second of the Archbishop's invitations: to explore the reduction of four parishes to three, and specifically – to consider the formation of one new parish to replace our current two parishes. This Committee included both Parish Councils and Finance Committees plus the members of KPAC.

The Committee appointed a Drafting Team comprising the Chairs of the two Parish Councils- Richard Ward and Michael Dodson, and the Chair of the KPAC, John Butterfield, to draft a plan of action about what each parish, separately and together, would need to consider in bringing this about, and to propose a time-frame for implementation of any proposals.

The Drafting Team will report back to the Committee by the end of October and was given the authority to issue progress reports jointly to both parishes.
